See Map on Back Page for specific burn location. USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) in partnership with EcoStudies Institute will perform a prescribed burn on a site enrolled in the Wetlands Reserve Program in Polk County, Oregon.

The exact date and time of the burn(s) will depend on weather conditions, but the burn(s) will take place sometime between:

Sept. 1 - Nov. 30, 2023

Easement Site Burn Area: 170 acres

Location: east of Baskett Slough National Wildlife Refuge, 5 miles northeast of Dallas

Private residences are adjacent to the burn area.


The burn(s) will be completed by professional prescribed burning teams and will be closely monitored by technical staff to ensure public safety. Minimal smoke impact is expected.

Prescribed burning is an effective land management tool that provides multiple benefits to the land, including healthier soils, and improved habitat for wildlife.
