- CSAs; selling directly to farmers markets or schools; or providing agricultural products to underserved communities

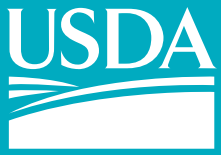




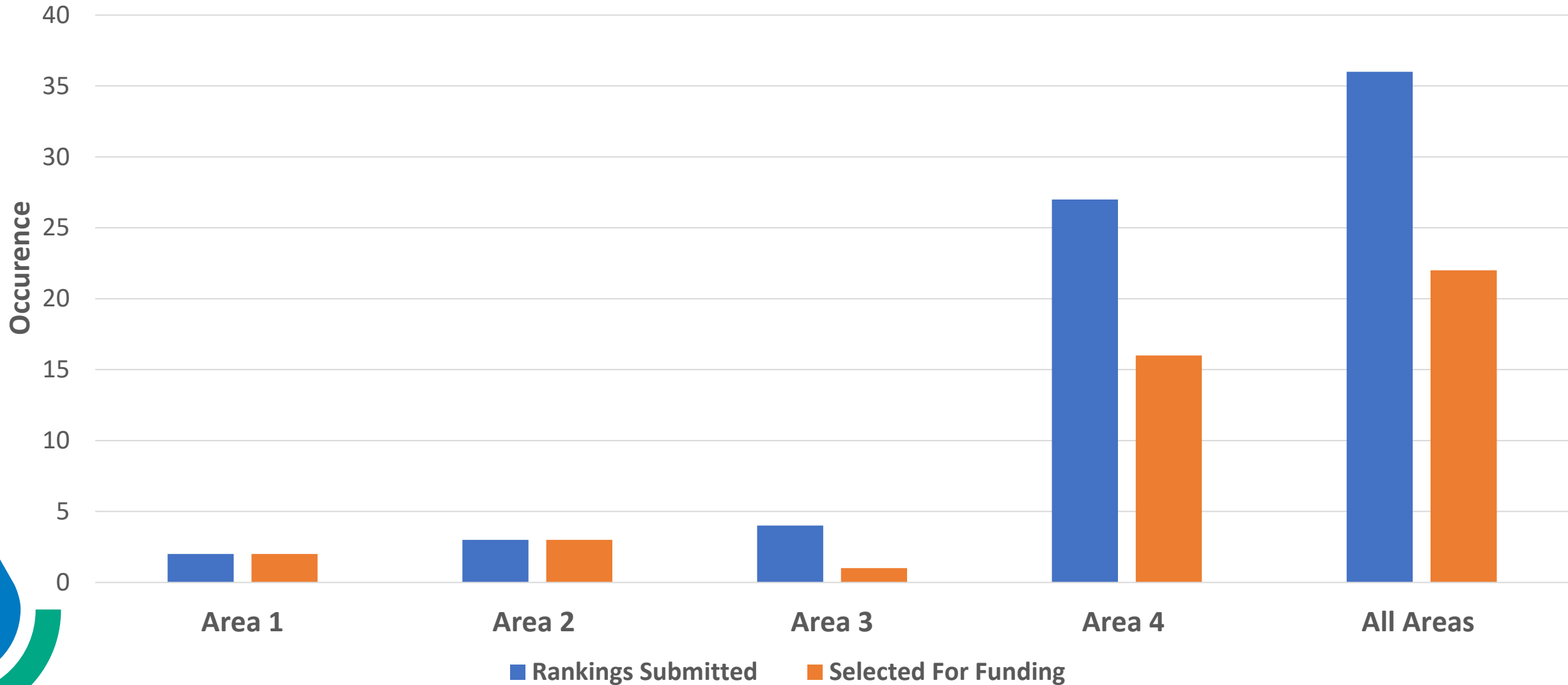
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NRCS California Structure

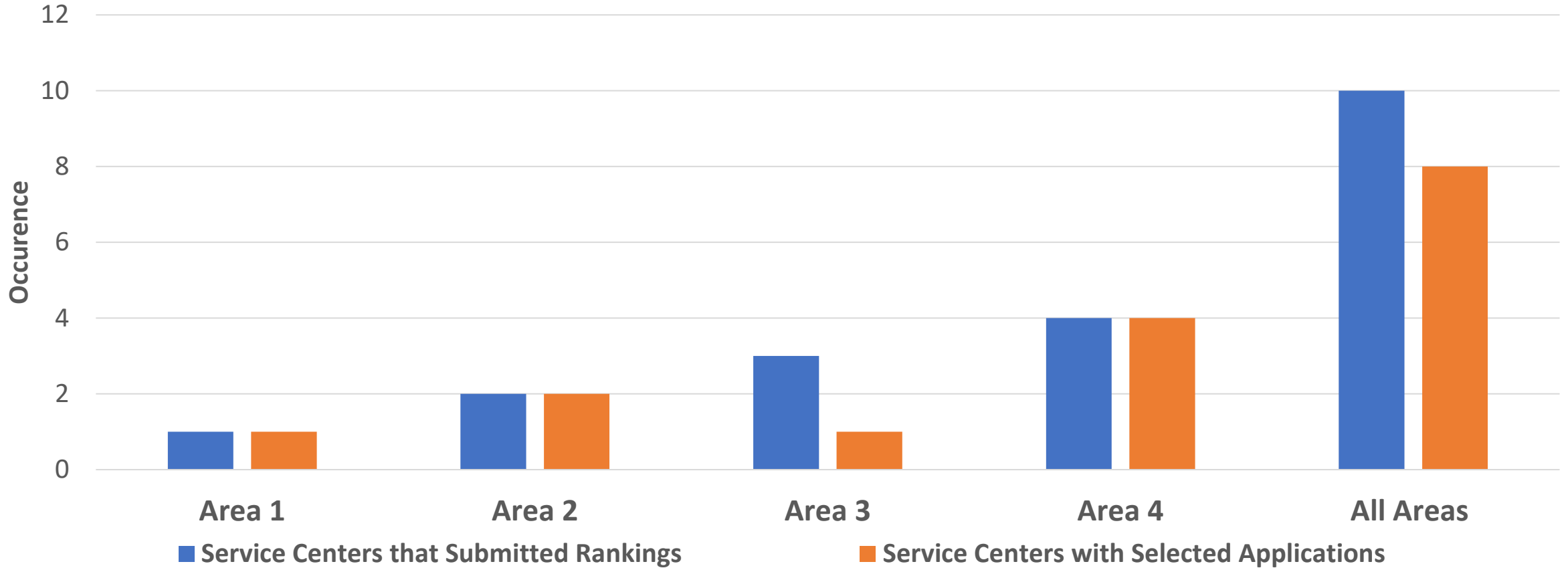




Applications Ranked and Selected For Funding by Area



Service Centers with Ranked and Selected Applications by Area

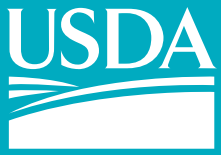


Area 1 service centers: Yuba City
