Conservation Activity Plans (CAPs) must be prepared by a certified Technical Service Provider (TSP). Plans must comply with 2014 national planning criteria posted in the eFOTG, Section III ([www.nrcs.usda.gov/technical/efotg](http://www.nrcs.usda.gov/technical/efotg)).

Each approved CAP is supported by a single, stand-alone program contract with plan development scheduled during the first 12 months after obligation. Contracting of multiple CAP contracts on the same land unit is prohibited, except for CNMP & AgEMP.

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
