




LEGEND

- LOAMY AND CLAYEY SOILS ON NATURAL LEVEES
- 1 COMMERCE-BROU association: Nearly level, somewhat poorly drained and moderately well drained, loamy soils
  - 2 DUNDEE-SHARKEY association: Nearly level, somewhat poorly drained, loamy soils and poorly drained, clayey soils
- CLAYEY, LOAMY, AND SANDY, FREQUENTLY FLOODED AND OCCASIONALLY FLOODED SOILS MAINLY BETWEEN THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER AND ITS LEVEE
- 3 SHARKEY association: Level, nearly level and gently undulating, poorly drained, clayey soils
  - 4 TENSAS-SHARKEY association: Gently undulating and level, somewhat poorly drained and poorly drained, clayey soils
  - 5 SHARKEY-BROU-COMMERCE association: Level, nearly level and gently undulating, moderately well drained, clayey soils and moderately well drained and somewhat poorly drained, loamy soils and frequently flooded
