


Plan View

Notes:

- Place brush piles near existing cover such as brushy areas, tall grass, or hedgerows
- The first layer of 6 to 12 inch logs are to be place parallel to each other 8 to 12 inches apart, with a second layer of similarly sized logs laid perpendicular to the 1st layer (crisscrossed)
- Avoid using snags, cavity, or mast trees to construct brush piles. These trees provide wildlife habitat in place
- Place no more than two to three brush piles per acre.
- Invasive and noxious species should be controlled in areas around the brush pile.
- Brush piles need to be maintained by periodically adding new limbs and branches
