


ISOMETRIC VIEW

MATERIALS LIST

USE 1" X 12" X 10' ROUGH CUT LUMBER.
 (CYPRESS RED OR TREATED PINE RECOMMENDED)
 ONE CEDAR OR TREATED POST LONG ENOUGH TO ALLOW
 2 SMALL HARDWARE HINGES,
 1 SCREEN DOOR HOOK AND EYES.
 ONE 12" X 4" X 1/4" MESH HARDWARE CLOTH.
 USE TWO 1/4" LAG SCREWS, 4" LONG, WASHERS
 AND 1"-2" SPACE BLOCKS TO ATTACH TO POST.
 6" OF SAWDUST & SHAVINGS.

NOTES:
 PLACE 5'-8' ABOVE HIGH WATER MARK. OR 10'-20'
 ABOVE GROUND.
 FACE OPEN WATER AND OPEN FLIGHT PATH TO BOX.
 BOXES SHOULD BE GREATER THAN 300' APART.
