

### **NJ511.8 Construction Plans**

(D) Construction plans for engineering practices to be installed under the Conservation Operations or Farm Bill programs may consist of job sheets where developed for simple practices, or both drawings and specifications for more complex practices. A complete construction plan shall provide:

- (1) sufficient information for accurate location and layout of the work;
- (2) adequate information for the contractor to construct the job as designed;
- (3) complete specifications describing the type and quality of materials to be used;
- (4) instructions as required by the construction specifications on methods and procedures required to accomplish the work; and
- (5) measures necessary to control erosion and sedimentation during construction.

(e) Except as provided for on job sheets or standard drawings, calculations will be prepared on separate computation sheets. Design calculation sheets should not be included with the cooperator or contractor copies of the construction plans. Calculations are a part of the design folder that may be copied for the cooperator upon request.

(f) At least two copies of all engineering drawings and specifications shall be provided to the cooperator for jobs prepared under the Conservation Operations or Farm Bill programs. It is the intent that the cooperator provides one copy to the contractor and retains one copy for personal use.

(g) Additional information and copies of computations, drawings, and specifications may be provided to the cooperator when it is necessary to obtain permits or approval.
