Title VI --

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) prohibits discrimination in all of its programs and activities on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, disability, and where applicable, sex (including gender identity and expression), marital status, familial status, parental status, religion, sexual orientation, political beliefs, genetic information, reprisal, or because all or part of an individual's income is derived from any public assistance program. Title VII --

USDA employees and applicants for employment who believe they have been subjected to employment discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex (including gender identity and expression), national origin, age (if 40 or over), disability, reprisal (for prior participation in an EEO activity or having opposed discrimination), political affiliation, sexual orientation, marital status, parental status, or genetic information, have the right to file an Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) complaint. You must contact an EEO Counselor within 45 days of the date of the alleged discriminatory act, event, or in the case of a personnel action, within 45 days of the effective date of the action. The EEO Counselor/Mediator will attempt to mediate/resolve the issue. To file a complaint, contact an EEO Counselor at 301-504-2181.
