

MICHIGAN AT-RISK INDICATOR SPECIES

INDICATOR SPECIES	HABITAT REQUIREMENTS (at completion of plan)
Bobolink (<i>Dolichonyz oryzivorus</i>)	Min. 40 acres of grassland habitats which has a minimum vegetative height of 6 inches throughout the growing season.
Northern Leopard Frog (<i>Rana pipiens</i>) Sora Rail (<i>Porzana Carolina</i>)	Property contains a min. of ½ acre of emergent open water wetlands with min. 50 foot undisturbed buffer.
American Woodcock (<i>Scopopax minor</i>)	Forestry management with emphasis on aspen management, uneven-aged shrub thickets and 1 acre open areas.
Wood Thrush (<i>Hyllocichla mustelina</i>)	Forests greater than 20 acres with trees greater than 40 feet tall and a shrub canopy.
Northern Bobwhite Quail (<i>Colinus virginianus</i>)	A minimum of 20 acres of habitat of which 15% of the habitat is in undisturbed grassland or shrub cover. This applies to all areas south of M-55.
