Animal Enhancement Activity – ANM01 – Drainage water management for seasonal wildlife habitat

Conditions where Practice Applies

1. The topography is relatively smooth, uniform, and flat to gently sloping.
2. A water table will be maintained without excessive seepage and without having an adverse impact on adjoining properties

Criteria

1. Drainage water will be managed using a water control structure or device.
2. Drainage water management will be planned, designed, and installed to meet all federal, state, local and tribal laws, and regulations.
3. NRCS eFOTG Drainage Water Management (554) standard will be followed.
4. The system shall provide saturation to the soil surface or shallow flooding at a maximum average depth of 18 inches to provide wildlife habitat.
5. Flooding will be maintained annually for a minimum of 60 days between September 1 and April 1.
