


Toolkit Client Data – What's Saved Where?



Toolkit Client Databases

National Conservation Planning Database
(NCPDB)

The NCPDB stores conservation plan data for every NRCS client across the nation.


Check Out

When you check out a client, you check out the portion of NCPDB that holds your client's data. This is the client's database.



Client Database



A client may have several plans in their database. The  **Select a Plan** button in Toolkit lets you choose which plan to work with.



Each plan contains its own geospatial land unit and practice features, along with the corresponding practice schedule information.




MXD Files

MXD files do not store data. They simply contain pointers to let ArcMap know where to go to get the data, and how to display it.

Non-data items such as bookmarks, annotation layers, and other graphics are stored in the MXD file in which they were created.



Choosing a plan with Toolkit's "Select a Plan" button points ArcMap to whichever one of this client's plans you currently wish to work with.



Since a client can have multiple plans in their database, you must always select a plan after opening an MXD file in Toolkit.
