Preferred Water Depth and Inundation Tolerance

Prefers moist soil. Species tolerates 1 inch of standing water for short durations. *C. granularis* is a flatwood and fen species.

Wildlife Value

Not available.

Application/Zone

Used in partially shaded upper shoreline zones.

Availability, Establishment, and Maintenance

- Has been observed recovering from soil seed bank.
- Germination is best from fresh seed.
- Store seed dry (14% moisture) cold, overwinter, and sow the following spring.
