ILLINOIS AGRICULTURAL WASTE MANAGEMENT FIELD HANDBOOK - NOTICE 15

Subject: National Engineering Handbook Part 651, Engineering Technical Materials

Purpose: To add listings of Illinois NRCS approved waste storage and handling structures as supplements to the Agricultural Waste Management Field Handbook

Effective Date: Upon receipt.

Explanation: Illinois NRCS has been working on approval for an additional manufactured waste storage and handling structure, practice code 313. Winkler Canvas, Ltd has agreed to improve the warranty on their hoop buildings, when funded by NRCS in Illinois. As a result, certain additional hoop style roofs have now been determined to meet NRCS standards and may be used in practice designs involving roof structures.

The approval of the listed structure depends on proper implementation of the certification procedure for each site-specific design, as outlined in the attached supplement. NRCS will not provide technical assistance for the design of these structures, beyond cursory review and approval. The program participant will be responsible for securing the services of an Illinois licensed engineer for design and construction certification.

This notice distributes Illinois supplements IL 10-64-29 and 10-64-30.
