During the last week of April NRCS Staffers Nathaniel Todea, Hydraulic Engineer, and Jonathan Tufuga, Human Resources Specialist, visited and met with students at three different colleges to recruit for 3 student temporary employment positions at the Aneth NRCS Field Office. This was part of the Utah Conservation Initiatives for the Utah-Arizona strip on Navajo Nation land.



Schedules were made to accommodate faculty and student schedules. Fortuitously, American Indian Science and Engineering Society (AISES) meetings were being held consecutively for two of the colleges visited---San Juan College and the Dine College. DC.

They also visited students at the Fort Lewis College.
