PUBLIC MEETING HELD ON LOGAN CANAL EWP

NRCS held a public meeting last night, March 31, in Logan to give all interested individuals, organizations and agencies an opportunity to learn more and comment on the Logan Northern Canal

Reconstruction Draft Environmental Impact Statement. NRCS State Engineer Bronson Smart said more than 100 persons attended to ask questions, view displays and record their comments for the record. NRCS has prepared the EIS for proposed repair, replacement, and/or modifications to the Logan Northern Canal system. During the spring of 2009, a slope failure occurred along a hillside in south Logan, resulting in damage to the canal and disabling the water distribution system. The canal is located in an unincorporated area of Cache County and the communities of Logan, North Logan, and Hyde Park. NRCS is assisting the sponsoring local organization, Cache County, through the Emergency Watershed Protection (EWP) Program.
