## NRCS EXHIBITS AT SWANER WATERSHED FESTIVAL

NRCS staffers Norm Evenstad and Barb Carey staffed an NRCS exhibit at the first annual Swaner Nature Preserve Watershed Festival held Saturday, June 10, near Park City. More than 40 vendors and 1200 people participated in the environmental education event.



At the NRCS exhibit, they discussed the Rapid Watershed Assessment process and several USDA programs, such as WHIP, WRP, and EQIP. Brochures on backyard conservation and the joint venture between the National Audubon Society and NRCS were distributed and participants could view the NRCS history DVD. Children were given a colorful, temporary conservation tattoo after taking the conservation pledge to protect our natural resources.
