JEFF BARNES RECEIVES NON-POINT SOURCE WATER QUALITY AWARD



Jeff Barnes, NRCS rangeland management specialist in the Logan field office, was awarded the 2007 Non-Point Source Water Quality Award by the Utah Non-Point Source Task Force during the September non-point source annual tour in Northern Utah. He was recognized for his 26 years of innovative conservation work in the Bear River Watershed, serving the landowners of Cache, Rich and Box Elder Counties. The award was presented by Nancy Mesner, associate dean of the College of Natural Resources at Utah State University.

In addition to his conservation work that benefits water quality, he serves as a member of the Utah Envirothon Steering Committee where he has given much of his personal time to help high school students learn environmental stewardship values in a unique competition environment.
