



Using the “Binocular” tool to find a tract on the FSA Common Land Unit

When in an ArcGIS map document (mxd file), turn on the CLU layer by placing a checkmark next to County CLU (where County is your county name).


Click on the Binocular tool




Fill in the following window with the appropriate information. Click Find.




In the box at the bottom, the instances of that tract will appear (one line per field within that tract). Hold down the Ctrl key and single left click on each instance of the tract.



Right click within the blue highlighted area and choose “select features”. After doing this the Find window can be closed by left clicking the red X in the upper right corner of that window.



The selected tract will now be highlighted in aqua in the view frame. To zoom to that field, click on the “zoom to selected feature” tool.



You will then be zoomed in to the extent of that tract.
