

Iowa Addendum: Water Quality Enhancement Activity – WQL03 – Rotation of supplement and feeding areas

CRITERIA clarification

2. Feeding locations includes all feed sources including hay rings, range cubes, DDGs, creep feeders and any other feed source.
4. Grazing Plan = Maintain minimum stubble heights for the primary forage functional group or species as shown in Table #1 of Iowa Agronomy Technical Bulletin #31. Maintenance of a minimum stubble height allows the planted species to establish and survive.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS clarification

1. Utilize an aerial photo or other map to show supplement sources and feeding areas each year of the contract.
2. Document when minerals and feeding locations were moved by calendar date.
3. Grazing Plan = Maintain minimum stubble heights for the primary forage functional group or species as shown in Table #1 of Iowa Agronomy Technical Bulletin #31. Maintenance of a minimum stubble height allows the planted species to establish and survive.
