All applications received by COB on
January 27, 2012 were ranked for the
2012-1 CSP ranking period

Conservation Stewardship Program 2012

- Received 140 applications of which:
 - 108 were eligible or pending
 - 13 ineligible
 - 19 cancelled

Conservation Stewardship Program 2012

- **CSP Contracted Acreage (rounded)**
 - 23,000 acres Ag Land
 - 3,250 acres Non-Industrial Private Forestland (NIPF)
 - 26,250 TOTAL CONTRACTED ACRES
- 57 contracts (46 Ag & 11 NIPF)
- \$770 K (annual payments)

Conservation Stewardship Program 2013

- Continuous Sign up
- Tentative application cut off date -
December 21, 2012 for 2013-1 sign up
- Possibility of 2nd sign up period

Farm and Ranch Lands Protection Program 2012


- 2012 Application period – One entity submitted an application which was funded for \$332,000
- Closed on three parcels in FY2012
 - Conservation easements on 550 total acres
 - Prime/statewide importance soils preserved – 530 acres

Farm and Ranch Lands Protection Program 2013


- New Farm Bill may implement some changes to program
- Waiting for guidance from National Office
- Currently FRPP funds have assisted in placing conservation easements on 186 parcels covering approximately 31,000 acres
