eFOTG Soils Fact Sheet 2
Farmlands Classification Systems for Vermont Soils
October, 2005

The publication “Farmland Classification Systems for Vermont Soils” is stored in the Electronic Field Office Technical Guide (eFOTG). This fact sheet contains directions on how to access and download this report from the eFOTG.

The report text and the soil survey legends are downloaded separately. You must have Adobe Reader loaded to access information in the eFOTG.

Steps

1. Log into the USDA-NRCS Vermont Home Page (<http://www.vt.nrcs.usda.gov>)
2. Click on eFOTG – on the left side under “Quick Access”
3. Click on Vermont on the US map (bookmark for future reference)
4. Click on any County on the state map to move to step 5 (any county will do, specific counties are selected below)
5. Click on Section II – on the left side of the screen
6. Click on “A. Soils Information”
7. There are 2 options
 - a. Statewide Soils Information
 - b. County Specific Soils Information
8. To download or print the report text.
 - a. Click on Statewide Soils Information
 - b. Click on Important Farmlands Classification Narrative – 2005
 - c. Adobe Reader Screen should appear.
 - d. Print the report using the print icon in Adobe Reader or
 - e. Save the file using the save icon in Adobe Reader
9. To download or print the county soil survey legend
 - a. Click on County Specific Soils Information
 - b. Click on the County that you want, for example: Addison County
 - c. Click on “Addison Important Farmland Ratings-Oct-2005”
 - i. Under other county directories, the county name begins the file name
 - d. The legend should appear in the Adobe Reader screen
 - e. Print the legend using the print icon in Adobe Reader or
 - f. Save the file using the save icon in Adobe Reader
10. Repeat Step 9 for additional county soil survey legends.
