

EQIP Poultry Litter Transfer Program

The purpose of the Poultry Litter Transfer Program is two fold: 1) to encourage the proper application of poultry litter on suitable agricultural lands in an environmentally responsible manner; 2) to promote management practices by end users to apply poultry litter according to guidelines in certified nutrient management plans. The Poultry Litter Transfer Program will help facilitate the use of poultry litter on areas not previously receiving litter and on soils that do not have a high phosphorus content. Incentive payments to end users are limited to three years.

Requirements for Eligibility

1. End users of poultry litter must have and follow a current Nutrient Management Plan which addresses the proper application of poultry litter.
2. A current soil test must show that phosphorus levels for fields receiving litter is at "Medium +" saturation levels or below according to Virginia Tech criteria. A current soil test for fields to be enrolled is required to qualify for the Poultry Litter Transfer Program.
3. Payments are for land that has not been previously receiving poultry litter.
4. End users must store and apply poultry litter in accordance with state standards with proper set backs from environmentally sensitive areas as defined in the nutrient management plan and applicable NRCS standards and specifications.
5. Manure stored for more than 14 days must be put under cover and placed in a manner that runoff will not become a pollutant. Cost-share may be available to construct a temporary storage facility.
6. End users must submit a signed "Field Application Record" and receipts for payment.
7. Poultry litter must come from one of the following "source" counties: Augusta, Rockingham, Page, Shenandoah, Prince Edward, Amelia, Nottoway, Accomac, Buckingham, and Cumberland.
