Abstract

The purpose of this guide is to identify and explain the functions of the buttons on the Toolkit Toolbar. The Toolkit toolbar is found in ArcMap.

Details



Zoom To Plan—to be used to zoom in to the digitized tract/fields.



Select a Plan—to be used to select the database you wish to work with.



Import Legacy Shapefile—to be used the first time you create an ArcGIS project with existing shapefile info from old Toolkit 4.1



Total Acres—to be used to calculate acres of a field or feet of a line.



Map Products—to be used to create a layout of your project.



Map Labels—to be used to enter field number, acres, HEL info etc.



Soils Map & Inventory—to be used to clip the soils for your planned land units and creates a field-by-field inventory for use in planning.



Buffer—to be used to buffer a selected polygon/line/etc.



Attribute Tool—to be used to attribute your fields/tract/acres/etc. It will also allow you to link to existing data.



New Toolkit Layer—to be used to create new land units, practices, resource inventory or your own layers.



Toolkit Digitizer—to be used to create and/or edit digitized layers.



Digitizing On—this icon is an indication that you are in edit mode.



Save Work—to be used to save a layout in .pdf format.
