Abstract


This guide will explain how and when to use the New Toolkit Layer Tool to create a practice.

Steps: New Toolkit Layer Tool; Practice, OK.

Details

Creating a practice layer allows you to display items (e.g. fence line, grass waterway, brush management) within a field without making them part of the field.

1. **Click** on the **New Toolkit Layer Tool**. 
2. **Select** the Practices point, line or polygon that you wish to make, and **click OK**. This layer is saved directly into the Toolkit personal geodatabase. The default layer name will be Practices [polygons, lines, or points]. Because it is going into the geodatabase you cannot give it a file name.



Note: You can make one layer for each geometry within a category. For example you can have a Practices (polygon) layer and Practices (line) layer and a Practices (points) layer. You will NEVER make more than one of each layer unless directed to do so.
