8. Apply manure uniformly and do not apply within 25 feet of surface waters.

9. Do not apply manure on in-field grassed waterways (unless a variance is granted).

10. Do not apply manure within 50 feet of water supply wells, mines, quarries sinkholes receiving surface runoff, or other direct conduits to groundwater. **Inject or incorporate** manure applications within 24 hours on land upslope from and within 300 feet of these features.

11. For land within 300 feet of surface waters:

- Do not apply manure with a traveling gun or center pivot irrigation system at any time and do not apply manure when ground is frozen, snow covered or actively thawing.
- Inject or incorporate manure within 24 hours **OR** install a 100-foot wide grass filter strip along surface waters and a 50-foot strip along intermittent streams and drainage ditches.
