
FIRST TIME SETUP OF CIVIL 3D 2010

THESE STEPS ONLY HAVE TO BE DONE ONCE UNLESS A NEW CUI and/or TEMPLATE ARE POSTED TO THE NRCS WEBSITE.

What program do I use: **AutoCAD Civil 3D 2010 Imperial**

1. Download the Custom User Interface (CUI) file from the NRCS website

The WI NRCS CAD team developed a CUI file ([WI Civil 3D 2010 CUI File](#)) on the WI NRCS Website

- To load the file:
 - In Windows Explorer browse to the following location: C:\Documents and Settings\firstname.lastname\Application Data\Autodesk\C3D 2010\enu
 - File > New > Folder
 - Name it “ORIGINAL CUI FILES”
 - Open the “Support Folder”
 - Edit > Select All
 - Edit > Copy
 - Go back to the folder you just made “Original CUI Files”
 - Edit > Paste
 - Open the “Support Folder”
 - Delete the C3D.cuix file
 - Click on the link above and Save the **C3D.cuix** file to the following location
:C:\Documents and Settings\firstname.lastname\Application Data\Autodesk\C3D 2010\enu\Support

2. Download the drawing template from the NRCS website

The WI NRCS CAD team developed a template file ([WI NRCS Civil 3D 2010 Template](#)) on the WI NRCS Website

- Click on the link above and save the template file on your C drive, S drive, or H drive.
- Open Civil 3D Imperial
- Type “options” at the command line.
- Under the “Files” tab scroll down and expand (click the +) for “Template Settings.”
- Click the + for “Default Template File Name for QNEW”
- Click on the path name > the select the “Browse” button on the upper right hand side. Browse to where you saved your template. (You may have to select Template File *.dwt as the “Files of Type” at the bottom of the browse dialog box).
- Once you find your file “open” > Apply > OK

You can now start new drawings using the help sheets on the WI NRCS website.
