§WI 541.01 Media and technique.

(c) NRCS, Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP), and field offices are purchasing Computer Aided Design and Drafting (CADD) systems. In the future this capability will be expanded to include more offices. These offices will have the capability to use and develop electronic drawings.

Electronic drawings will be classified as being structural or non-structural. See NEM Part 536.

(d) New electronic drawings are to be developed using Wisconsin NRCS CADD Standards. This will ensure a consistent format and allow easy revision.

(e) Existing Wisconsin standard drawings that are converted to an electronic drawing, will be submitted to the NRCS state office for checking, final approval, and distribution.

§WI 541.02

(a) Drawing sizes and sheet sizes shall be as follows:

(1) Current NRCS standard drawing E size (21" x 30"), N size (10 1/2" x 15"), or L size (8 1/2" x 11").

(2) Industry standard D size (22" x 34") or B size (11" x 17"). NEM 541.20 gives the dimensions of the borders and layout for the title block for these two sizes.

(b) Drawing sizes should be as consistent as possible within a set of construction plans.
