Downstream Dam Hazard

- High Hazard**
A dam where failure or mis-operation will probably cause loss of human life.
- Significant**
A dam where failure or mis-operation results in no probable loss of human life, but can cause economic loss, environmental damage, disruption of lifeline facilities, or impact other concerns. These dams are often located in predominately rural or agricultural areas but could be located in areas with population and significant infrastructure.

- Low**
A dam where failure or mis-operation results in no probable loss of human life and low economic and/or environmental loss. Losses are principally limited to the owner's property.
- Low Road**
Hazard the same as low with the exception that there is a potential for road damage.
