


SOIL ASSOCIATIONS *

- 1 Holdrege association: Deep, nearly level to very gently sloping, silty soils on loess-mantled uplands
- 2 Holdrege-Coly-Uly association: Deep, very gently sloping to steep, silty soils on divides and drainageways in the loess-mantled uplands
- 3 Hord-Cozad-Hall association: Deep, nearly level to gently sloping, silty soils on stream terraces and narrow bottom lands
- 4 McCook-Munjoy-Inavale association: Deep, nearly level to very gently sloping, loamy soils on bottom lands

* Texture refers to surface layer of major soils in each association.
