SUBJECT: TCH—Conservation Practice Narratives

Purpose. To provide guidance in using conservation practice narratives for conservation planning and conservation program contracts

Expiration Date. September 30, 2013

Conservation practice narratives are developed by national and state data stewards for the use of field staff to plan and describe appropriate levels of conservation. Local data stewards (supervisory district conservationists [SDCs]/district conservationists [DCs]) are not to alter national- or state-developed narratives.

Existing state and national conservation practice narratives available through Customer Service Toolkit are to be used without alteration to their original content. **Use of a national narrative should only occur when a Kansas narrative does not exist, such as for Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) enhancement activities.** Instances may arise for the need to document additional practice information within the narrative. This may be done **ONLY** if existing field sheets, job sheets, and/or construction specifications do not adequately address the implementation of a conservation practice.
