| <p><sup>1</sup> A higher payment rate has been set for any participant that qualifies as a Limited Resource Farmer or Rancher, or Beginning Farmer or Rancher.</p> <p><sup>2</sup> Practice eligible for use with tree and shrub plantings associated with the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) electronic Field Office Technical Guide (eFOTG) practices 380, 612 and 650.</p> <p><sup>3</sup> Practices are eligible on land planted to permanent vegetation meeting NRCS eFOTG standards and specifications of 512 or 550.</p> <p><sup>4</sup> This practice will be installed for the entire crop rotation or contract length whichever is longer; a minimum three crop type rotation will be installed.</p> <p><sup>5</sup> Requires at least 30 percent deferral during the growing season to be eligible for payment.</p> <p><sup>6</sup> This is a one time payment for the period of adoption. Practice will be implemented a minimum of three years. Payment will be made upon initial implementation of the practice on all contracted acres.</p> |   |                 |
