


CREATING A CUSTOMIZED MENU PALETTE

A customized menu palette can be created which provides only those drop-down menus that you use most frequently across the top of the screen. This cuts down on the number of times that you must change menu palettes when working on tasks that typically include commands that are located on more than one menu palette.

Access the Menu Customization window through Customize on the Tools drop-down menu. The Menu Customization window can also be opened by typing `menuload` at the command line.



Click on the Menu Bar tab to bring up a list of all of the drop-down menus currently displayed across the top of the screen (the window on the right) as well as a list of all of the drop-down menus available (the window on the left). The available menus are further organized into menu groups so changing the menu group that is selected on the left will bring up different available menus.


Search through the various available menu groups and insert them into the menu bar list in the right-hand window. If the Insert>> button is not active, it is because the menu you have selected on the left is already in the Menu Bar list. Remove drop-down menus that you do not want from the Menu Bar list and move the ones you want to keep up or down to organize them in the order you want them to appear on the screen.

When you are finished organizing the list of drop-down menus in the Menu Bar window, click on the Close button. The drop-down menus at the top of your Land Desktop screen should now appear as you organized them in the Menu Customization screen.


Your drop-down menu settings can now be saved to a customized menu palette that you can bring up at any time. To do this, open the Menu Palette Manager under the Projects drop-down menu. Note: if you have not included the Projects drop-down menu in your choices across the top of the screen, the Menu Palette Manager can still be opened by typing `MP` at the command line.

When the Menu Palette Manager window appears, click on the Save button to save your customized menu palette.



You will now be prompted to enter a name for the new menu palette.



You should now be back at the Menu Palette Manager window. Your newly created menu palette should show up in the listing on the left and is ready to be used just as you would any of the standard menu palettes.
