

## Screening Criteria

### Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) - Sediment Removal Pilot NATIONAL SCREENING CRITERIA WORKSHEET - Fiscal Year 2013

***A Screening Worksheet is required to be completed for each EQIP application.***

<b>Instructions:</b>			
This screening worksheet must be completed for each eligible producer applying for EQIP assistance for the Sediment Removal Pilot. Applications will be accepted on a continuous basis; however, cutoff dates are established for purposes of ranking and funding allocation. The goal of this screening tool is to ensure that conservation technical assistance and EQIP program benefits are efficiently allocated to address priority projects.			
Completion of this worksheet and documentation does not constitute agreement to provide EQIP program benefits or approval of an EQIP contract. The original screening worksheet should be filed with the applicant case file or EQIP program file and the screening priority (High, Medium, and Low) must be recorded in ProTracts. Upon request, a copy of any completed screening worksheet may be provided to the applicant.
