	<sup>3</sup> Eligible ONLY in Kansas Water Office, Groundwater Management District, and Division of Water Resources designated Quick Response Areas. Incentive is authorized when this practice is installed for conversion from irrigated land to non-irrigated land on 100 percent of the application acres. <b>Incentive is only authorized on the converted acres and must be taken for three years.</b>	
	<sup>4</sup> This is a one time payment for the period of adoption. Practice will be implemented a minimum of three years. Payment will be made upon initial implementation of the practice on all contracted acres.
