1	A higher payment rate has been set for any participant that qualifies as a Limited Resource Farmer or Rancher (LRF), Beginning Farmer or Rancher (BF), or Socially Disadvantaged Farmer or Rancher (SDF). LRF, BF, or SDF may apply under the ranking category specific to their resource concern, or the ranking category specifically for their historically underserved group.
2	This is a one-time payment to encourage the participant to hire a technical service provider for completion of the Conservation Activity Plan (CAP). This practice is not eligible for payment if the Natural Resources Conservation Service completes the CAP.
