**SUBJECT: PDM–Assignment of Watershed Projects**

**Purpose.** To assign responsibility for each operational Public Law 83-566 (PL-566) watershed project and resource conservation and development (RC&D) funded dams.

**Expiration Date.** September 30, 2013

The intent of making specific project assignments is to improve communication and to facilitate operations, especially where details of personnel are necessary to complete approved projects. Area engineering responsibility for active watershed projects is assigned as follows:
