## **Animal Enhancement Activity – KS-ANM19 Wildlife corridors**

### **Kansas Criteria for National Animal Enhancement Activity – ANM19**

1. For interior fences, wildlife-friendly fence bottom wire is no lower than 14 inches and the top wire is no higher than 42 inches, with no more than four wires.
2. Woven wire mesh (hog wire) fence is not allowed.
3. When in Lesser Prairie-Chicken range, fence markers will be added to top wires in areas where fence is in close proximity to and between booming grounds and nesting areas.
  - a. A minimum of four markers will be placed between each two posts on all upright and functional fences.
  - b. Markers will be made of materials that will withstand the elements for a minimum of five years (e.g., vinyl siding).
  - c. Markers will be white or other light color and be a minimum size of three inches by three inches.
4. Label directions will be followed with Windows/Pesticide Screening Tool (WIN/PST) when applying chemical to control invasive vegetation.
