Subpart C – Responsibilities, Coordination, and Funding

KS400.20 Responsibilities.

(e) State Conservationists and Directors of the Pacific Basin and Caribbean Areas are responsible for:

(2) The state resource conservationist is designated to serve as the state coordinator for cartography, remote sensing, Global Positioning System (GPS), geodata, digitizing, and Geographic Information System (GIS) activities.

(m) State (and equivalent) GIS Specialists are responsible for:

(1) Providing technical leadership in development, acquisition, and integration of critical state geospatial datasets.
