**KANSAS BULLETIN NO. KS120-12-3**

**SUBJECT: ADS—Purchasing Ethanol 85 Percent Fuel**

**Purpose.** To provide guidance on the purchase of alternative fuel

**Expiration Date.** September 30, 2013

Executive Order 13149 requires that alternative fuel (Ethanol 85 percent [E-85]) be used to the maximum extent possible when available locally, unless:

- It is not reasonably available because the alternative fuel cannot be obtained within a 15-minute drive or within five miles (one way).
- It is unreasonably expensive costing at least 15 percent more than gasoline on a gasoline gallon equivalent basis.

To locate current and newly established fueling stations that offer E-85 alternative fuel, go to <http://www.afdc.energy.gov/afdc/locator/stations/>.

Currently there are 39 fueling stations listed on the above website. As of February 24, 2012, several of the stations do not have E-85 fuel. See the attachment for the listing, with stations that no longer carry E-85 fuel denoted. Place a copy of this bulletin and the E-85 fueling stations list in each vehicle that uses E-85 fuel.
