SUBJECT: MGT—Kansas Natural Resources Conference, January 26-27, 2012

Purpose. To provide information and authorize attendance of the subject conference

The 5th annual Kansas Natural Resources Conference will be held January 26-27, 2012, at the Airport Hilton, 2098 Airport Road, Wichita, Kansas. The theme for the conference is "Wetlands: The Jewels of Kansas."

Employees interested in acquiring the technical training being provided should submit a completed [registration](#) form through proper channels to their management team (MT) member by December 7, 2011. MT members will send approved registration forms to Muriel Morgenthaler by December 14, 2011. The state office will notify MT members of those employees approved to attend. The state office will handle submitting registration forms and fees to the conference registration chair.

Employees authorized to attend will be responsible for making their own hotel reservations at the Airport Hilton or other nearby motel. The block of rooms will be held until January 11, 2012. Reimbursement will be at established government per diem rates (\$86 for lodging and \$56 for meals and incidental expenses). Registration includes lunch on Friday so travel vouchers need to reflect a corresponding deduction.

Event sponsors are the Kansas Chapter of the American Fisheries Society, the Great Plains Society of American Foresters, the Kansas Chapter of The Wildlife Society, the Kansas Section of the Society for Range Management, the Kansas Chapter of the Soil and Water Conservation Society, and the Kansas Alliance for Wetlands and Streams.
