6. Forestry Technical Note 8	Tree Planting Tally Worksheets for Forest Ecological Sites on the Island of Hawaii. Names updated based on final adopted ESDs. "Transitional" ESD plant list for Kona Dry to Kona Wet removed; this was not a final ESD. Herbaceous species (primarily ferns) removed - not eligible under forestry planting practices. Full scientific names detailed for each plant entry - selected plants must match specified species names. Hawaii island ESD names may be updated due to national naming convention changes. These Hawaii island ESD plant lists may be replaced by a digital PIA Vegetative Guide. Naio (<i>Myoporum sandwicense</i>) removed from all Big Island ESD plant lists due to ongoing severe impacts from <i>Myoporum</i> thrip (<i>Klambothrips myopori</i>).
