## Hawaii State Level Agreement – Cultural Resources

### Conservation Practices Considered as Undertakings

*Some conservation practices have the potential to cause effects to cultural resources, assuming such resources are present, because the potential is high for disturbing the ground when installed according to standard NRCS criteria. Such practices are considered undertakings and cultural resource consideration and Section 106 compliance is required.*

*The following conservation practices, as found in the NRCS Pacific Islands Area Field Office Technical Guide (FOTG), and in consultation with the State Historic Preservation Division, are **Considered as Undertakings** in the State of Hawaii:*
