Agronomy Technical Note No. 6: HEL Worksheets for the Pacific Islands East Area Revised January 9, 2007	The technical note is used to determine if a field is considered highly erodible land (HEL) or non-HEL (NHEL) based on water and wind erosion. It consists of seven separate EXCEL worksheets, one each for the six major Hawaiian Islands and one for the island of Tutuila, American Samoa. The worksheets were revised to correct an error in the LS Factor lookup table formula. Worksheets for the PI West Area islands are under development.

The technical note is the second in the Pacific Islands Area Technical Notes series. The PI Technical Notes are a continuation of the existing Hawaii Technical Notes series. The other PI areas may use existing Hawaii Technical Notes, if they are applicable to their area.
