### **ABSTRACT**

Web Soil Survey, originally released in 2005, is a web application (<http://websoilsurvey.nrcs.usda.gov/>) that is the primary delivery mechanism of official soil survey data for the National Cooperative Soil Survey. Users with an internet web browser (e.g., Internet Explorer<sup>®</sup>) can access, view, print, and/or download for their geographic area of interest: soil maps, numerous reports, interpretations, thematic maps, and more. Since the inception of Web Soil Survey, enhancements and additional functionality have been added. This poster displays some of the many improvements of the soon to be released (July, 2008) version 2.1.
