

## CADD NOTE 4

Several of the CADD Notes refer to commands that are NRCS developed routines. These commands require various support files to be available in order for the command to work properly. For Missouri NRCS computers, these are installed as part of the Autocad install procedure and so no further user action is needed.

For other computers, these support files are available as a single install file (NRCS\_MO\_CADDSetup.exe) found on Missouri's NRCS website:

Simply download the file and then run it. You should then start AutoCAD (without Eagle Point) to complete the setup process. You should receive a message that the profile has been updated. You should then exit and restart AutoCAD.

Most of the support files are installed to the C:\ACADNRCS folder and have been tested with Autodesk Map 5 and Autodesk Map 3D 2006. No promises are given for compatibility with other versions. If Eagle Point software is installed on your computer, a few support files related to Eagle Point will also be installed.

The install program mentioned above should take care of adding the needed search paths to Autocad's options. If for some reason it doesn't, the following entries should be added under Autocad *Options -> Files* tab

*Support File Search Path*

C:\ACADNRCS\Support

(insert this at the top)

C:\ACADNRCS\Symbols and Blocks

(near the bottom is fine for this one)

*Customization Files -> Enterprise Customization File*

C:\ACADNRCS\Support\NRCS\_MO

After adding these manually, you should exit and restart AutoCAD.
