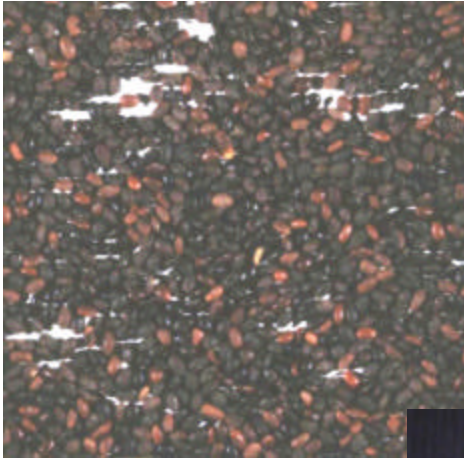

FOREWORD

Acquisition of seeds and plants for conservation use is often hampered by a lack of knowledge of vendor locations and the materials they supply. Local farm and ranch centers are able to supply seeds of common crop varieties as well as locally adapted grasses and legumes. However, often these centers do not carry or have access to seed and planting stock of many plants that are popular for wildlife plantings, rehabilitating drastically disturbed lands, and other conservation uses.

The USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), Jamie L. Whitten Plant Materials Center developed this seed and plant vendors directory to serve as a reference to assist conservationists, reclamation and restoration specialists, and others in locating vendors of plant materials used for resource conservation and environmental programs. This directory is not intended to provide a complete listing of vendors or plants adapted to the southeastern US, and the mention of any vendor does not indicate endorsement by NRCS, nor does NRCS guarantee availability or quality of seeds and plants produced by any vendor listed. No discrimination of other suitable plants and cultivars is intended. For other vendors of plants not mentioned in this directory go to the Plant Materials Program website at <http://Plant-Materials.nrcs.usda.gov>.

The directory contains the following:

- A list of seed and plant vendors by state, address, telephone, and fax number (Section A).
- A list of herbaceous and woody plants for conservation use in Mississippi sorted alphabetically by common name (Section B). Plant species within sections are grouped by plant type.

Scientific nomenclature follows the PLANTS database, which is the accepted authority for NRCS use. Several names may be different than those with which the reader is familiar.

How to use the directory:

The first step is to locate the desired plant in the directory by its common name in Section B. Adjacent to the plant name column is a vendor ID column which contains a list of codes for seed and plant vendors of that plant. Once you have located a vendor(s) from the list, then refer to Section A to find the information on those vendors.

⇒ For example, you wish to find a supplier for 'Quail Haven' reseeding soybean (*Glycine soja*). After locating 'Quail Haven' in Section B, you will find MS004. This vendor is Southern Wildlife Management, P.O. Box 1212, Senatobia, MS and the telephone number is (662) 562-6980 or (662) 562-9405.
