

Landowner Offer for Wetland Reserve Program Easement

Instructions: The landowner may choose to make an offer if they will accept less than the geographic area rate cap. The Landowner(s) shall check the appropriate box, enter the offer amount and then and date the document. Landowners are **not** required to make a written offer, but can choose to do so to increase their ranking. The maximum offers are 100% for a permanent easement and 75% for a 30-year easement. Landowners may increase their ranking by making an offer that is less than the maximum amount. This is applicable only for Permanent and 30-year Easement applications.
