Subject: ECS – THE “RUMINANT FEED BAN” ANIMAL PROTEINS PROHIBITED IN RUMINATE FEED
FEDERAL RULE 21 CFR 589.2000

Purpose. Provide direction concerning immediate removal of internal and external animal nutrition publications which contain Specified Risk Material within livestock forage and feed additive nutritional tables.

Expiration Date. December 30, 2007

Background. Certain materials are banned as a nutrient source or additive for ruminant animals. Older publications used as a reference source or available to the public may contain information regarding the use of materials as a feed source that is now prohibited by law.

Explanation. This bulletin is notification to Centers and States to review all publications concerning ruminant animal nutrition. Publications found to contain reference or recommendations for use of these prohibited material should not be distributed. As appropriate, discard the publication or add pen and ink edits identifying that the substance is prohibited by law as a source of feed to ruminant animals.
