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Footnotes:

1/ The maximum cost-share rate is 75% for all structural or vegetative practices. Management practices or components with cost type of "FR" are not eligible for cost share under a WHIP Conservation Program Agreement, but may be included as a non-cost-shared (NC) item in the Agreement. Other practices in the Field Office Technical Guide that are not listed above may also be included as NC items in the WHIP Agreement if needed as a supplemental practice.

2/ The practice Hold Down is the maximum amount of cost-share for the total units of the practice scheduled in the WHIP Conservation Program Agreement.

3/ These practices are eligible only if needed in support of the implementation of a Fish Passage (396) project.

4/ This practice is eligible only in support of an Early Successional Habitat Development/Management (647) project, where high quality forage is needed to meet the nutritional needs of a targeted wildlife species.

5/ These practices are eligible only if needed to provide a replacement source of water for livestock that will be excluded from direct access to a significant riparian water source (stream, spring, pond, or lake) in order to directly benefit fish or wildlife species.

6/ This practice is eligible only if needed in support of a Wetland Enhancement (659) or a Wetland Restoration (657) project.
