

FASCINE BUNDLE DETAIL

GENERAL NOTES

1. Woody material shall be 1/2 to 2 inches in diameter and not less than 4 feet in length (L).
2. Fascine bundles shall be tied with untreated twine every 1 to 2 feet.
3. The plant material should be dormant, stripped of leaves and irrigated.
4. Place and firmly compact soil over and around fascine leaving approximately 30% of upper branches exposed.
5. Stakes used to secure the live fascines should be 2.5 feet long, untreated, 2x4 lumber, split diagonally.
